Directions: Choose and complete an assignment after you have read/responded to your novel. Highlight the assignment you chose. Read a new novel, complete response journals. Choose another assignment, this time it must be from a different square. Highlight this one and repeat.

Comment: An approach combining learning styles with responses to novels. Each quadrant has activities typical to one learning style. Students are free to choose which activity they will complete to respond to a given novel, however, they will be forced to try other quadrants with subsequent novels.
